



Speech of the Rector of Antonine University Father Michel Jalakh Scientific Congress and Exhibition 2019 29 March 2019

Honorable Guests, Dear students and faculty members, Dear colleagues and friends,

The World Health Organization's "World Oral Health Report 2003" emphasized that even though great improvements have been achieved in the oral health status of people across the world, problems still persist. The major challenges for the future will be to translate present knowledge and proven experiences of disease prevention and health promotion into concrete programs, benefiting from the improvements in oral health science to the fullest possible extent.

The WHO Oral Health program gives priority to research, thus helping correct the so called 10/90 gap, which relates to the notion that only 10% of funding for global health research is currently allocated to health problems that affect 90% of the world population. Since knowledge is one of the major vehicles for improving the health of the poor particularly, the WHO Oral Health Program focuses on the stimulation of oral health research in the developed and developing world to minimize risk factors and the burden of oral disease, and also to improve oral health systems and to increase the success of community oral health programs. Establishing and supporting research capacity is highly recommended.

In line with this global concern, the main objective of this gathering that takes place every two years is to help developing informative and constructive continuing dental education programs, in order to enhance the performance of dental professionals and oral health care providers in the region.
