### 1. Presentation

UA within its internationalization strategy which aims to support its activities, is launching a call for application to all students to participate in a study mobility (**one semester**) at [University of Calabria](#), Italy, for the **Spring Semester 2025–26**.

The call is part of the inter-institutional agreement between COMMO IX - UNIMED and Antonine University on International Credit Mobility (ICM), co-funded by the ERASMUS+ programme of the European Union.

### 3. Duration and Funding

The study mobility is planned to take place during the second semester of the academic year 2025–26, for a duration of 2 to 5 months maximum.

The amount of 900 euros per month is allocated as individual support with 360 euros for travel expenses.

**Are eligible, UA students in CCE (4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> year) and master's in business administration (1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year)**

The deadline for submission for the **Spring Semester 2025–26** is September 5, 2025.

- English certificate Level B2
- University enrollment certificate
- Official transcript of grades
