Rondine World House Program (2nd cycle)



1. Presentation

Rondine Cittadella della Pace is a no-profit organization committed to reducing armed conflicts Worldwide, situated in Rondine, a medieval village in Tuscany, Italy. It is within Rondine that the primary educational projects are developed, providing a dual opportunity to participants: the regeneration of the inner selves and the enhancement of leadership skills. Participants will attend a one-year First Level Specializing Master (60 ECTS).

2. Funding and duration

The 1-year program timeline is divided as follows: 1st semester (July 2026 – December 2026) 2nd semester (January 2027 – June 2027) 3rd semester (July 2027 – December 2027).

During the residential phases of the program, the Association takes responsibility for covering the following costs:

- Training and engagement activities at Rondine (including the online phase);
- Food and accommodation;
- University tuition and related expenses (learning material, transportation, etc.);
- Health insurance, residence permit.

Expenses under the responsibility of the student include the travel expenses to/from Italy and visa procedures, holiday travels, personal and medical expenses, and any other costs not mentioned above.

3. Eligibility Criteria

- Aged between 21- 28
- Holder of a Bachelor's Degree (or earned by June 2026), or Master's Degree
- Engaged in civil society, willing to bring a positive change in their communities and the world

We strongly recommend youth showing predisposition to the following characteristics to apply:

- Sensibility and readiness to work on the topics of conflict of the country of origin and conflicts in general, Leadership, goal-oriented, Recognize and express emotions (theirs and in a group), Community life, Public speaking and communication, Team work, active listening and proactivity, Volunteering and community engagement, Knowledge about civil society and the non- profit sector and sensibility to major global issues.
- Italian is the official language for communication and activities **but it is not a precondition to apply.**

- Copy of the last academic diploma earned;

- Recommendation letter (one or more);
- Notice on personal data protection (hand-signed)

Applicants must submit the required documents by **the deadline 22 February 2026**.

After the full completion of the program, you will receive: An Academic Degree (M1), Certificate of Achievement of the World House Program, become a member of Rondine International Peace Lab, the alumni network, Impact Project well designed and ready to be implemented.
