> Scholarships Based on the Baccalaureate Official Exams Grades

Students who enroll at UA directly after graduating from high school may benefit from a discount based on the results of the Baccalaureate official exams. These scholarships cover either totally or partially the cost of their **first-semester** tuition fees as specified below:

General Average	Discount Percentage
15–16.49/20	20% Discount for the Fall Semester
16.5–17.49/20	40% Discount for the Fall Semester
17.5–18.49/20	60% Discount for the Fall Semester
18.5/20	100% Discount for the Fall Semester

> Sports Grants

The eligibility criteria to receive the sports grants include:

- Being a first or second-division player and a member of any UA team sport
- Being engaged in individual sports
- Being a current Lebanese champion
- Holding an international title

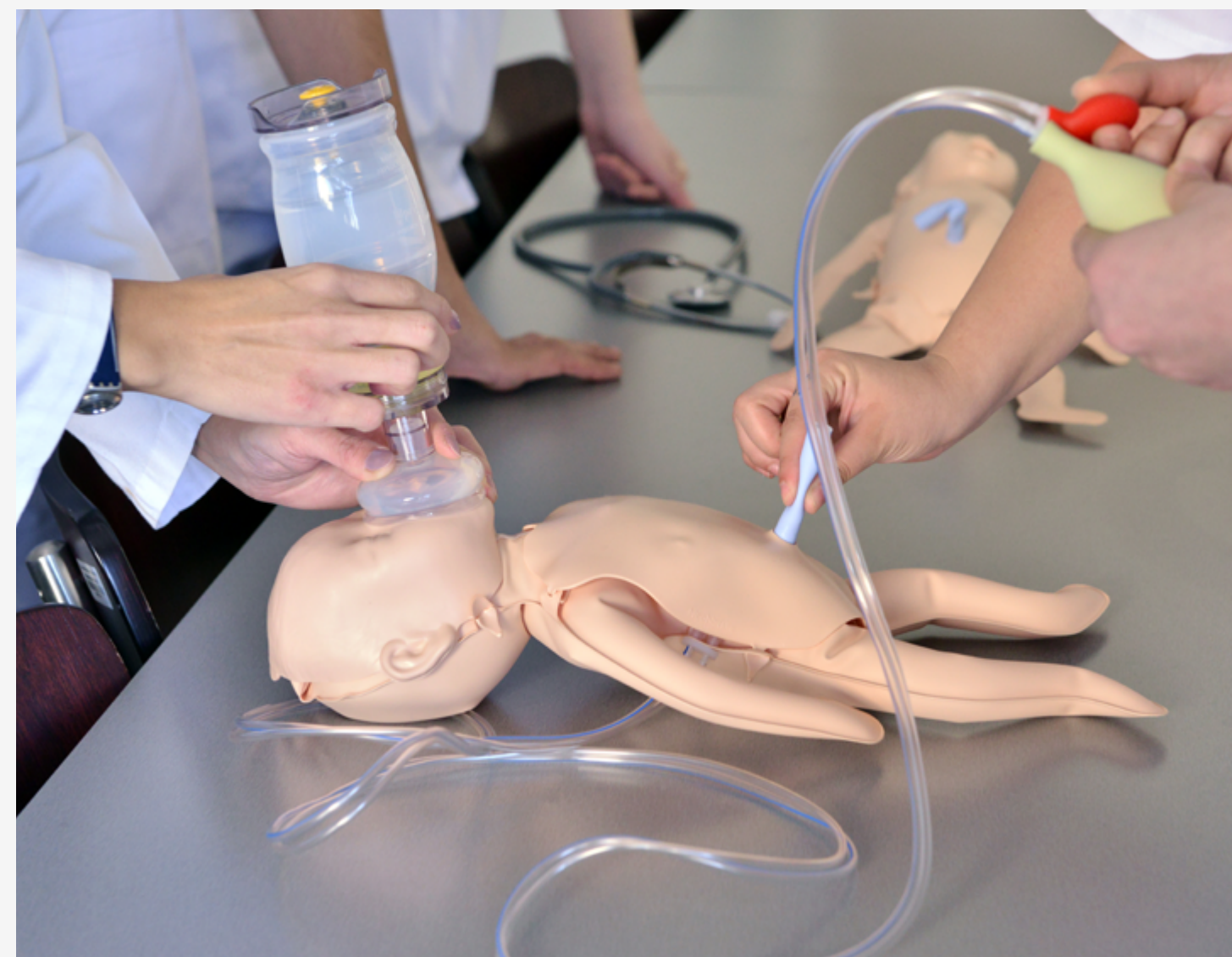

The purpose of these labs is to bridge the gap between academic theory and real-world practices, allowing students and researchers to work hands-on with cutting-edge methodologies.

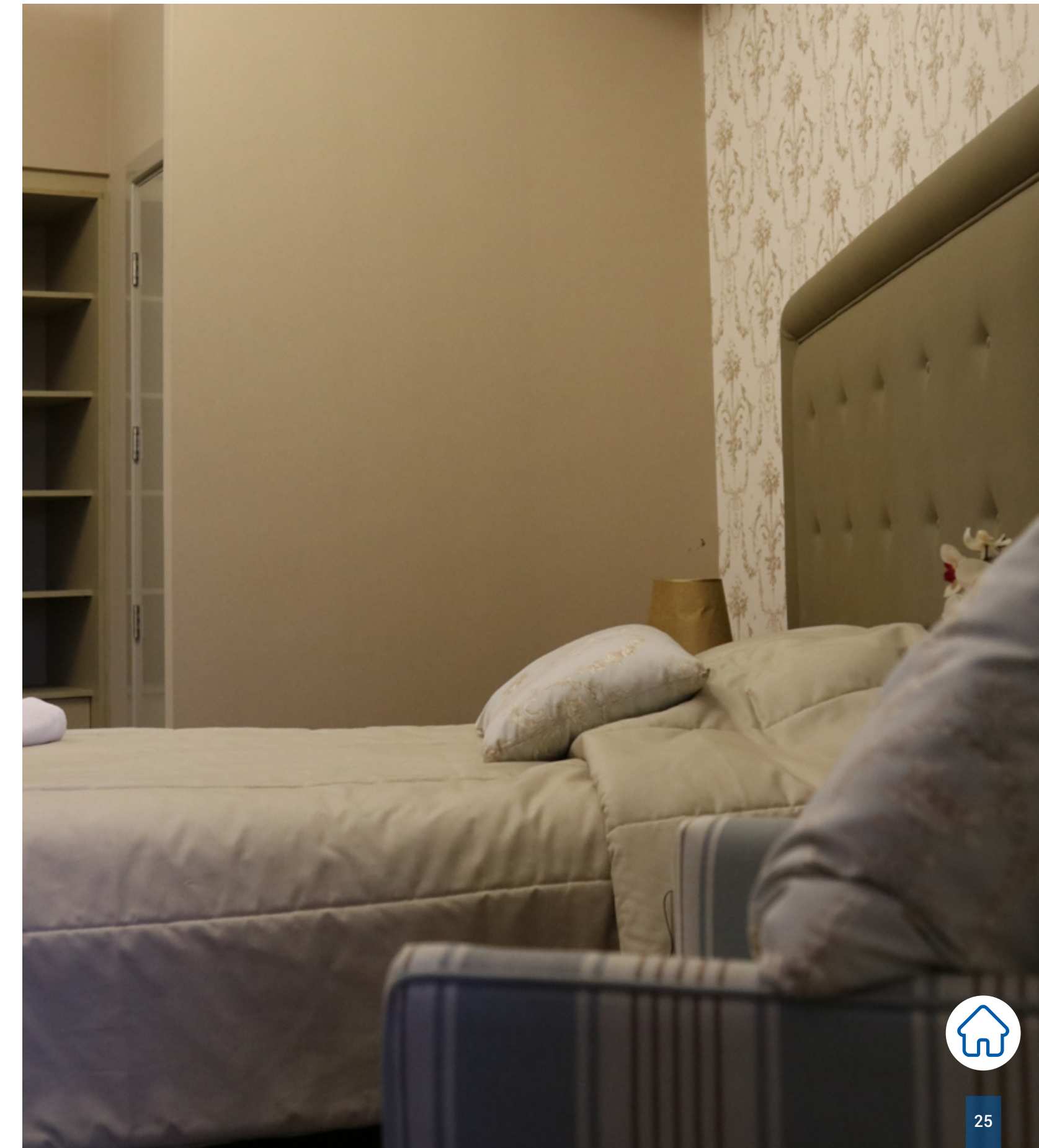


Housing

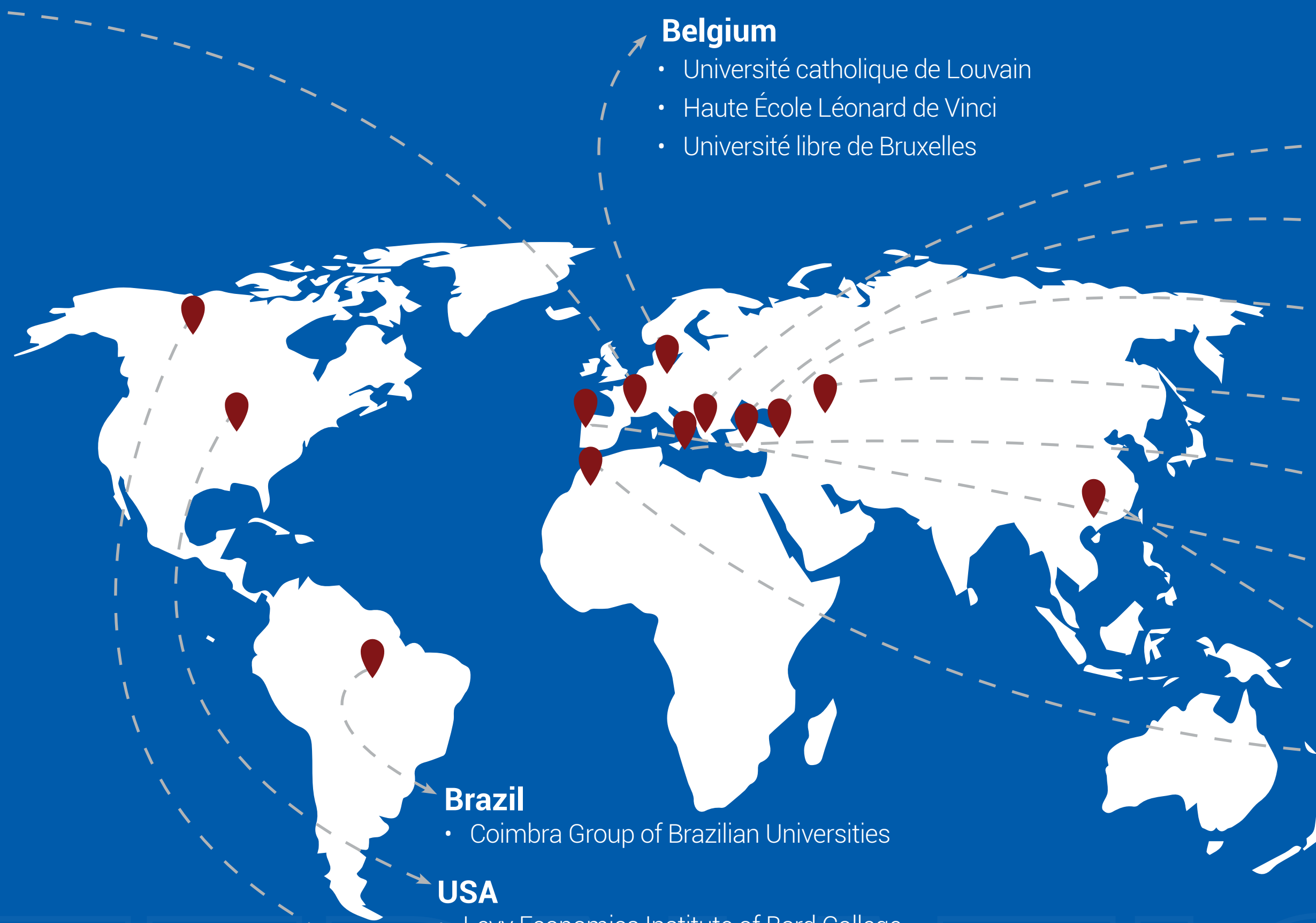
